Awarded to a graduating student, attending a Grand Prairie school, with a “C” average or better and who is planning to pursue post secondary education following graduation. High School Transcript, two letters of recommendation and an essay are required. Participants in an Arts Council production or event will be given special consideration.

Amount: \$1,000

Deadline: May 16, 2023 (postmarked or emailed)

2023 Grand Prairie Arts Council Volunteer Scholarship

Description: This scholarship is intended to reward a student for volunteering for the Grand Prairie Arts Council. Awarded to a graduating Grand Prairie student with a “C” average or better, planning to pursue post-secondary education following graduation. High School Transcript, two letters of recommendation and an essay are required. Preference will be given to those students who have helped out over a year’s time OR periodically over two or more years.

Amount: \$1,000 (one may be awarded)

Deadline: May 16, 2023 (postmarked or emailed)
